1. With this circular you will receive the new edition (January 1957) of the "Isabella" spares list A. Besides the part numbers used so far ten-digit part numbers are entered in this list.

These new notations have been employed after a certain system and we suggest to observe the instructions made on page 3 - 4 C.

In order to enable our authorized dealers to adapt their spare parts stock- and price card index to the new spare part numbers - which requires some time - it will be necessary in the first time to keep on ordering spares according to the old part number system. Further notes regarding this are to be found on the supplementary page included in each spare part list.

However we recommend to change the spare part stock- and price card index as quickly as possible as orders with old part numbers will not be executed after the date of transposition has been announced by the Works.

The spare parts list A only contains parts for the standard "Isabella" saloon and as appendix a preliminary list of our type "Isabella-T.S.". It is planned to publish a spare parts list "B" which comprehends all special types, i.e. Station Wagon, Cabriolet, "Isabella T.S.", right hand steering etc. Until then the preliminary appendix "Isabella T.S." as well as the special list "Station Wagon" (old parts list, starting on page 135, edition August, 1955) which already is in your possession, remains valid.

2. From chassis 1 100 840 (234 139 Station Wagon) shock absorbers with limited stroke are installed in the type "Isabella". These shock absorbers are already mentioned in the new spare parts list A on page 42 (part No. 055 033 01 03) and page 65 (Part No. 055 033 01 04). By installing these shock absorbers the safety straps used so far become obsolete.
